SPECIFIC DUTIES and QUALIFICATIONS:

- Primarily responsibility is to safely drive IMS Museum (IMSM) tour busses around the Indianapolis Motor Speedway oval and infield to conduct tours for IMS Museum guests.
- Must be willing to accept a flexible work schedule, and willing to work some early mornings, evenings and weekends.
- Must have a valid driver's license, with a valid CDL B with P endorsement, and pass a drug screening.
- In order to be part of the team that will continue to grow and protect the IMS Museum brand, drivers must possess the following qualities and agree to the following actions:
 - o Must be good with people, a "people person," and make customer service the top priority.
 - Must be physically able and willing to assist persons with disabilities on and off tour busses;
 must be willing to learn how to safely use a built-in bus handicap lift.
 - o Must be physically able to clean IMSM busses after each tour.
 - Must be willing to work in a team environment and assist tour guides with guest questions and requests.
 - Must adhere to IMS and IMSM rules pertaining to safe driving on the grounds; must also adhere to IMS and IMSM social media policies and other rules that protect the IMS and IMSM brands and confidential information.
